## **Zion Kids Policies**

A top priority for our Zion staff and volunteers is to offer high quality faith formation opportunities for children and families. We are also committed to providing as safe an experience as possible.

#### Please join us by following these general safety policies!

SUPERVISING KIDS Because our Zion property is open to the public, we kindly ask that parents and guardians attend to their children at all times. Our staff and volunteers are required to accompany children at all times while children are checked into programming. Keeping this policy consistent helps the children to understand our safety concerns and acts as a deterrent to unsafe people or situations. Thank you!

CHECK-IN AND CHECK OUT All children Age 0-Grade 5 must be escorted both in and out of the building by an adult authorized on the child's registration form. Adults will initial a form at both arrival and departure. To change or add to your list of authorized adults, contact Ann Campbell or Lee Neitge.

**NAME TAGS** should be worn at all times by participating children and volunteers. Knowing who is who is an important safety feature.

FOOD/SNACKS To protect kids with food allergies, prior permission from the directors is needed to serve food.

HEALTH FORMS are required for children and youth who participate in Zion's Children's Ministries.

You only need to complete one form per child per year. Paper forms are available upon registration. You can also complete a form online at <a href="https://www.zionanoka.org/registration.events">www.zionanoka.org/registration.events</a>

SICK KIDS POLICY Protect your child and others by keeping home a child who is obviously ill with coughing, fever, diarrhea, vomiting, green-runny nose, puss/oozing eyes, or an infectious disease or condition (i.e., ringworm, head lice, chicken pox, measles, mumps, pink eye). Children with a fever over 100.4° F should not attend programming until 24 hours after their temperature resolves without fever reducing medicines.

AT ZION... We focus on positive choices, behavior, and relationships. Every child is uniquely created by God, and deserves loving attention and encouraging direction. We encourage kids to love God, love one another, and be safe. If you have suggestions for ways we can help your child to have a positive experience, please let us know!

WHAT NOT TO BRING Toys, games, electronics. (They get lost and broken.) Cell phones and smart watches should be kept in a separate location like a backpack. BTW, a Lost and Found is located outside the CYF office!

WHAT TO BRING Bibles for grades 2-5. (Kids can also use our class Bibles.)
